GRANDE RESERVA 2013

Country: Portugal

Region: Alentejo (Estremoz)

Soil: Clay / limestone

Type: Red

Grape Varieties: Alicante Bouschet (50%), Petit Verdot,
Syrah and Touriga Nacional.

Alcohol Content: 14,5%

Total Acidity: 5,6 g/l

Volatile Acidity: 0,68 g/l

pH: 3,53

Total Sugar: 0,8 g/l

Box: 6 bottles / carton

Open 2 hours before consuming and serve at a temperature between 18-19° C.

This wine, vinified with selected grapes from old vines, is fermented in ancient marble “lagares”, using the traditional foot-treading method. Slowly matured in new French oak barrels for one year, the wine shows a dark ruby colour and a rich, wild fruit aroma, connecting with mint and spices. The flavour is intense and round, with silky tannins and a persistent finish.
